The boring stuff:

- Please ensure that we have an up-to-date Registration form for your child. You can find this on our website https://www.115club.co.uk/reg-form.php
- Children can arrive & depart at any time during the day.
- Please note that for offsite activities and trips, there are additional costs to cover higher staffing ratios and use/hire of the minibus. There may also be additional venue costs.
- Please speak to the Club Leader regarding timings of organised activities or trips.
- Your child will need to bring a packed lunch for the day. (If only attending half day we would recommend they do bring a packed lunch or ensure they have had lunch before they arrive for an afternoon session). We will give a morning and afternoon snack.
- 115 Holiday Club is a **NUT FREE ZONE** so please ensure that no nuts or food containing nuts is brought into Club.
- Please ensure that your child brings weather appropriate clothing i.e. a coat as we will try to get outdoors for play each day even with light rain, or hat and sun cream in the hot sunny weather.

Mobile Phones/other electronic devices:

All electronic devices should <u>not</u> be brought in for the following reasons:

- 1. Conflict with the Club vision, which is to encourage and enable children to play and interact with other children.
- 2. Children have lost expensive games or attachments. This causes disruption as staff are forced to suspend what they are doing with children in order to search for such items. We also seek to avoid a situation where children and their parents are frustrated and disappointed when we are unsuccessful in our efforts to trace these items.
- 3. Children refusing to turn them off or arguing with each other about them.

We thank you for your help and co-operation with regard to this matter and hope that you appreciate that these measures are in place to ensure a consistent approach to all children attending the Club.

BICYCLES AND SCOOTERS: If you would like you child to bring a bike or scooter to use at Club please ensure that they bring helmets & lock so that the children are safe and the bikes can be secured outside if there are a lot.
